Role Responsibilities

- Experience cross-training between other departments (Ticketing, Business Development, Marketing, etc.) to obtain a “big-picture view” of the role they play in events
- Coordinate the Championship Volunteer Program alongside the volunteer coordinator

Required Skills/Qualifications

- Currently enrolled in undergraduate courses in an event management and/or hospitality related field (second year or higher preferred)
- Able to handle stressful situations on-site with tact and professionalism
- Must be detail oriented and a self-starter
